

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RE: MODIFYING JUDICIAL ASSIGNMENT
OF WEST SLOPE JUVENILE DELINQUENCY CASES**

Effective June 1, 2020, all West Slope delinquency filings, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 602, et seq., shall automatically be assigned upon filing to Judge Michael J. McLaughlin for all purposes. This assignment shall apply to all pretrial matters and trial, including, without limitation, detention hearings.

All delinquency hearings shall be set in Department 4 at the South Lake Tahoe location of the El Dorado Superior Court.

- South Lake Tahoe delinquency matters shall be heard on Thursdays at 8:30 a.m.
- West Slope delinquency matters shall be heard on Thursdays at 10:00 a.m.
- Detention hearings shall be set as necessary in Department 4, generally at 8:30 a.m.
- Contested matters in West Slope delinquency cases shall, when necessary for the convenience of witnesses, be scheduled for hearing before an assigned judge in Placerville.

All filings in West Slope delinquency cases shall be filed in Placerville with copies of all filed documents provided by email to the clerk in South Lake Tahoe. The original file for all West Slope delinquency cases shall be maintained by the clerk in Placerville. A working copy of all West Slope delinquency files shall be maintained by the clerk in South Lake Tahoe.


Except as may be necessary for contested matters, and until further notice, all delinquency hearings shall be conducted by remote appearance via Zoom videoconference in order to reduce exposure of detained youth, county and court staff, counsel, and the public to the COVID-19 virus. When the court resumes personal appearances, it will continue to offer

remote appearance via Zoom for the convenience of detained and non-detained youth, probation, parents, and counsel.

This order modifies subsection C of Local Rule 2.00.10 (Judicial Assignments; Placerville Session) and shall remain in effect until the Governor of the State of California appoints a judicial officer to fill the current judicial vacancy and the Presiding Judge assigns a judicial officer to Department 8.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
