**SIXTH AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RE:
WEEKEND AND INTERVAL JAIL SENTENCES TO BE SERVED AT THE
EL DORADO COUNTY JAIL BETWEEN 03/17/2020 AND 01/03/2021**

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the proclamations of a state of emergency by President Trump, Governor Newsom, and the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors, and at the request of El Dorado County Sheriff John D'Agostini, the Superior Court of El Dorado County issues the following administrative order:

All defendants currently serving a jail sentence on weekends or in intervals will have their sentence modified as follows:

- 1) All current commitments will be suspended until after January 4, 2021
- 2) Any defendant currently serving a weekend or interval sentence is ordered to contact the El Dorado County Jail at 530-621-6007 for commitments being served at the Placerville jail and 530-573-3031 for commitments being served at the South Lake Tahoe Jail.
- 3) El Dorado County Jail staff are authorized to reschedule sentences being currently served on weekends or in intervals to recommence on a date on or after January 4, 2021.
- 4) El Dorado County Jail staff are ordered to provide the El Dorado County Superior Court department which imposed the sentence the dates and times of the new sentence.
- 5) If a sentenced prisoner currently serving a weekend or interval sentence fails to reschedule his or her sentence and/or fails to report to begin serving the rescheduled sentence, El Dorado County Jail staff are ordered to send a non-compliance notice to the El Dorado County Superior Court department which imposed the sentence so that appropriate action can be taken.

For defendants who are scheduled to commence a weekend or interval sentence from March 17, 2020 through January 3, 2021, the court issues the following order:

- 1) Defendants scheduled to commence a weekend or interval sentence between March 17, 2020 and January 3, 2021, are ordered to contact the El Dorado County Jail at 530-621-6007 for

commitments to be served at the Placerville Jail or the El Dorado County Jail at 530-573-3031 for commitments being served at the South Lake Tahoe Jail.

2) El Dorado County Jail staff are authorized to reschedule all weekend or interval sentences scheduled to commence between March 17, 2020 through January 3, 2021 to begin on a date on or after January 4, 2021.

3) El Dorado County Jail staff are to advise the El Dorado County Superior Court department issuing the sentence the dates and times of the new weekend or interval sentence.

4) If a defendant ordered to serve a weekend or interval sentence scheduled to commence between March 17, 2020 through January 3, 2021 fails to appear on their scheduled date to reschedule their sentence, fails to reschedule their sentence at all and fails to appear on the original date, or who fails to report to serve the rescheduled sentence, El Dorado County Jail staff are ordered to send a non-compliance notice to the El Dorado County Superior Court department which imposed the sentence so that appropriate action can be taken.


In the event the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department is able to recommence the weekend and interval jail sentence programs prior to January 4, 2021, they have the discretion to have sentences commence on an earlier date.

The El Dorado County Jail is authorized to deem all weekend or interval prisoners who only have one day left to serve as time served, and there will be no need to reschedule the remaining day.

This order does not apply to any other form of alternative sentence being served other than weekend or interval commitments to the El Dorado County Jail, and it does not apply to weekend or interval commitments being served in another county.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
