

1. GUARDIANSHIP OF CHANDLER O., GARRETT O. & GAVIN O. PP-20180216

Annual Status Review Hearing

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on February 27, 2019. The guardianship of Chandler and Garrett already terminated by operation of law. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council Form GC-251) concerning Gavin was submitted by the guardians. Having read and considered the report, the court finds and orders that the guardianship remains necessary and shall continue.

Review Hearing Re: Submission of Report Card

On March 23, 2022, the court granted the guardians' petition to fix the ward's residence outside of California. The court notes that a status hearing regarding the establishment of a guardianship in Tennessee is set for March 29, 2023.

7. GUARDIANSHIP OF GUNNER R. 22PR0281**Petition to Appoint Guardian**

A friend of the proposed ward's family petitions to be appointed guardian of the person. The proposed ward's mother objects to the petition.

"Upon hearing of the petition, if it appears necessary or convenient, the court may appoint a guardian of the person or estate of the proposed ward or both." (Prob. Code, § 1514(a).) The court applies a clear and convincing evidence standard of proof to its determination of whether or not it appears necessary or convenient to appoint a guardian, whether or not granting custody to a parent would be detrimental to the child, and whether or not granting custody to the nonparent is required to serve the best interests of the child. (Guardianship of Jenna G. (1998) 63 Cal.App.4th 387, 394.)

Petitioner filed the mandated (1) Confidential Guardian Screening Form (Form GC-212); (2) Declaration Under UCCJEA (Form FL-105/GC120); and (3) Consent of Proposed Guardian (Form GC-211). Petitioner needs to complete and file the required Child Information Attachment form for the Probate Guardianship petition (Form GC-210(CA)) and the Duties of Guardian and Acknowledgment of Receipt form (Form GC-248). Further, with regard to the Confidential Guardian Screening Form, petitioner needs to respond to question number 1(b) and provide Attachments 6 and 14 in response to question numbers 6 and 14 of the form.

Notice

There is no proof of service in the court's file showing that the mother and father were personally served with the notice of hearing and a copy of the guardianship petition. (Prob. Code, § 1511(b).) However, the father executed and signed item number 4 of Form GC-211 consenting to the appointment of a guardian and waiving further notice. The father also consented to the appointment of petitioner as guardian at the bottom of page 4 of 4 of the guardianship petition.

There is no proof of service in the court's file showing that the proposed ward's siblings (if age 12 or older) and his grandparents were served by mail with the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 1511(c).)

Reports

There is no DOJ live scan report concerning petitioner and his live-in girlfriend (the sister of the proposed ward) in the court's file.

The court investigator's report was filed on January 11, 2023.

The court applies a clear and convincing evidence standard of proof to its determination of whether or not it appears necessary or convenient to appoint a guardian, whether or not granting custody to a parent would be detrimental to the child, and whether or not granting custody to the nonparent is required to serve the best interests of the child. (Guardianship of Jenna G. (1998) 63 Cal.App.4th 387, 394.)

The proposed ward’s mother is deceased and her father is incarcerated. The father executed and signed item numbers 2 and 4 of Form GC-211, nominating petitioner to serve as guardian, consenting to the appointment of a guardian, and waiving further notice.

The paternal grandfather and maternal grandmother are deceased. The proposed ward’s siblings and paternal grandmother were served by mail with the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 1511(c).)
