**Review Hearing Re: Aryanna's Report Card**

**Annual Status Review Hearing**

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on January 2, 2007. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council Form GC-251) concerning the ward was not submitted by the guardians.

### 3. GUARDIANSHIP OF HALEY P. 22PR0331

#### **Petition to Appoint Guardian**

The paternal grandmother and paternal step grandfather of the proposed ward petition to be appointed guardian of the person. Letters of Temporary Guardianship of the person were issued on January 11, 2023.

“Upon hearing of the petition, if it appears necessary or convenient, the court may appoint a guardian of the person or estate of the proposed ward or both.” (Prob. Code, § 1514(a).) The court applies a clear and convincing evidence standard of proof to its determination of whether or not it appears necessary or convenient to appoint a guardian, whether or not granting custody to a parent would be detrimental to the child, and whether or not granting custody to the nonparent is required to serve the best interests of the child. (Guardianship of Jenna G. (1998) 63 Cal.App.4th 387, 394.)

Petitioners filed the mandated (1) Child Information Attachment form for the Probate Guardianship petition (Form GC-210(CA)); (2) Duties of Guardian and Acknowledgment of Receipt form (Form GC-248); (3) Confidential Guardian Screening Form (Form GC-212); (4) Declaration Under UCCJEA (Form FL-105/GC120); and (5) Consent of Proposed Guardian (Form GC-211).

#### Notice

The mother executed and signed those sections of Form GC-211 nominating petitioners to serve as guardians, consenting to the establishment of a guardianship, and waiving further notice. The paternal grandmother, one of the petitioners, submitted a declaration of due diligence concerning her efforts to locate her son, the proposed ward’s father. Having read and considered the declaration, the court finds that service of the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition should be dispensed with because the father cannot with reasonable diligence be given notice. (Prob. Code, § 1511(g); Cal. Rules of Ct., rule 7.52.)

The proposed ward’s maternal grandparents and paternal grandfather were served by mail with the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition on January 31, 2023. (Prob. Code, § 1511(c).)

DOJ live scan reports concerning petitioners have been submitted.

To date, the court investigator's report has not been filed.

Annual Status Review Hearing

Petition for Termination of Guardianship

On January 20, 2023, the guardians filed a petition for termination of guardianship. The petition indicates that the former guardian of the ward is willing and able to take over the guardianship.

The court investigator's report, filed on March 6, 2023, recommends that the guardians' petition be granted. The report states that the prospective successor guardian applied for guardianship in Stanislaus County and there is a court date set for March 27, 2023.
