

**1. Guardianship of Mariah A 25PR0312
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on November 6, 2025. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on December 3, 2025. Due to defective service, the court continued the initial hearing on January 7, 2026 to February 11, 2026 and reissued the temporary guardianship with new letters. The court received the probate investigator report on December 31, 2025 which recommends that the petition be granted. The court has not received the Department of Justice background results. There are no notices of hearing for any individuals entitled to notice. Proposed guardians request that the court dispense with notice to the biological parents. It appears that since the filing of the petition the biological father has come back into Mariah's life, which the court infers means that the proposed guardians may now have contact information for him. Upon review of the file, the court finds that the father has only been served by mail, not personally as required by the code. As to the biological mother, it appears that she has consented to the guardianship and waived notice of the hearing. While the court finds that the guardianship appears to be necessary and appropriate, the court orders appearances to resolve the notice issues.

**2. Guardianship of Zoie Z. 26PR0070
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on March 19, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on April 1, 2025. The court has yet to receive the investigative report from Quest. At the April 1, 2026 hearing, the court found that the mother consented to the guardianship and waived notice of the hearing. The court further dispensed with notice as to the father for the hearing on the temporary guardianship only. Upon review of the file, there is no proof of notice of the hearing for the father for the hearing on the permanent guardianship nor is there a declaration of due diligence. There additionally are no proofs of notice to any of the other relatives entitled to notice.

**3. Guardianship of Robert V. PP20160002
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW**

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on June 23, 2016. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian for the review hearing on May 13, 2026. The guardian appeared, and the court continued the matter to give her an opportunity to complete the annual status report. The court still has not received the report.

**4. Guardianship of Samara, Katelyn, and Micah Stoner 26PR0064
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on March 17, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on April 1, 2025. The petition requests only guardianship of the estate, and the proposed guardian is the biological mother who needs the guardianship to obtain life insurance benefits for the minors. The court finds that all notice have been given as required by law. Absent objection, the court grants the petition.

TENTATIVE RULING #4: ABSENT OBJECTION, THE COURT GRANTS THE PETITION FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF THE ESTATE. THE LIFE INSURANCE PROCEEDS FOR THE MINORS SHALL BE PLACED IN A BLOCKED ACCOUNT PER THE PROPOSED ORDERS. THE COURT SETS AN ACCOUNTING HEARING ON MAY 19, 2027 AT 1:30 P.M. IN DEPARTMENT 8. GUARDIAN IS DIRECTED TO FILE AN ACCOUNTING WITH THE COURT AT LEAST TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF THE HEARING.
