

**3. Guardianship of Serenity B. 26PR0112
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on April 21, 2026. The court has yet to receive a guardianship study conducted by Child Protective Services. The court finds that notice has been given for the hearings for permanent and temporary guardianships to the minor's parents via personal service and to the parents, maternal grandparents, maternal aunt, and paternal grandmother via mail service. Proposed guardians request that the court dispense with notice to the paternal grandfather as the parents have provided no contact information for him, including his name, so the proposed guardians have no way to ascertain his whereabouts. The court finds good cause to dispense with notice as to the paternal grandfather for the hearing on the temporary guardianship but directs the proposed guardians to inquire again of the parents as well as the parental grandmother as to his possible identity and address. The court finds that not all questions were completed on the confidential screening form, so the court needs to inquire of the parties as to one item. Provided this issue is resolved, the court is inclined to grant the temporary guardianship.

**4. Guardianship of Adrianna S. 23PR0250
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

On March 30, 2026, the guardians filed a motion to modify father's visitation with the minor, which was served by mail on both parents. Father has not filed a response. The court orders the parties to appear.

**5. Guardianship of Deja H. 26PR0025
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on February 10, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on February 25, 2026. The court received the guardianship study conducted by Child Protective Services on March 27, 2026 which recommends that the petition be granted. At the hearing on April 8, 2026, the court noted that it had yet to receive the Department of Justice background results and that notice had not been given to the minor's parents nor to one of the siblings of the minors. Upon review of the file, neither of these issues have been resolved since the last hearing.

**2. Guardianship of Elladee V. 26PR0107
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on April 16, 2026. Both parents and the paternal grandfather signed a consent for appointment of the paternal grandmother as the guardian. Not all questions were answered in the confidential guardianship screening form. While the court is inclined to appoint the proposed guardian as the temporary guardian, the court needs to inquire regarding the missing items on the screening form.
