

**1. Guardianship of Cecilia A. 26PR0077
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on March 23, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on April 1, 2026. The father signed a signed a consent for appointment of the proposed guardians. At the April 29, 2026 hearing, the matter was continued to May 13, 2026 to give proposed guardians an opportunity to serve mother with notice. The mother and proposed guardians appeared at the May 13, 2026 hearing. Mother initially objected, but then consented to the temporary guardianship pending the next hearing and also consented to the minor traveling with the temporary guardians out of the country. The court still has not received the investigator's report.

**2. Guardianship of Arianna M. 26PR0158
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on June 1, 2026. The father signed a signed a consent for appointment of the proposed guardians. The mother signed a consent to the guardianship and waiver of notice, filed on June 1, 2026. Notice was given to the maternal grandfather and grandmother. The court finds that the proposed guardians exercised due diligence in attempting to locate the father and his parents. The court dispenses with notice to the father and paternal grandparents. The court finds that appointment of a temporary guardianship is necessary and appropriate pending the next hearing.

TENTATIVE RULING #2: THE COURT APPOINTS THE PROPSED GUARDIANS AS THE TEMPORARY GUARDIANS PENDING THE NEXT HEARING ON JULY 22, 2026 AT 1:30 P.M. IN DEPARTMENT 8.

**3. Guardianship of Landon H. 26PR0119
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on April 28, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on May 20, 2026. At the May 20, 2026 hearing, the court dispensed with notice to the mother and maternal grandfather and directed that the father be personally served. Per the June 15, 2026 proof of service, the father was served on May 12, 2026. The court finds that notice has been given to the paternal grandfather and maternal grandmother. The court has yet to receive the investigative report.

TENTATIVE RULING #3: GIVEN THE LACK OF AN INVESTIGATIVE REPORT, THE COURT REISSUES THE TEMPORARY GUARDIANSHIP WITH A NEW EXPIRATION DATE OF JULY 29, 2026. THE COURT CONTINUES THE HEARING TO JULY 29, 2026 AT 1:30 P.M. IN DEPARTMENT 8. THE COURT FINDS THAT NO FURTHER NOTICE IS NEEDED FOR THE NEXT HEARING DATE.

**4. Guardianship of Debra and Rita A. PP20140164
ANNUAL STATUS CASE REVIEW**

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on March 25, 2015. The annual guardianship status reports (Judicial Council for GC-251) were filed on by the guardian on March 16, 2026. Having read and considered the report for the April 15, 2026 hearing, the court had concerns about the minors' progress in school and orders the parties to appear to inquire further. No parties appeared, so the court referred the matter to Quest for an investigation under Probate Code section 1513.2, subdivision (a) and continued the matter to May 13, 2026. Quest requested a continuance of the matter to have more time to complete the report. The guardian appeared at the May 13, 2026 hearing, and the court continued the matter to June 17, 2026. There is still no Quest report in the file, so the court again continues the matter to July 29, 2026 at 1:30 p.m. in Department 8.

TENTATIVE RULING #4: THE COURT CONTINUES THE HEARING TO JULY 29, 2026 AT 1:30 P.M. IN DEPARTMENT 8.
