

**1. ADRICH v. KALANIS AT LAKE TAHOE, ET AL., 23CV0980****Final Accounting Hearing**

On January 22, 2026, the court entered a stipulated judgment for final approval of class action settlement.

On February 25, 2026, the settlement administrator submitted a declaration identifying the status of defendant's payments to fund the Gross Settlement Amount of \$216,000. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, defendant is required to make a total of 36 monthly payments of \$6,000 beginning July 1, 2024, with the first payment due 14 days after final approval of the class action settlement. As of January 29, 2026, 19 monthly payments have accrued, totaling \$114,000 due. The settlement administrator has received from defendant a total of \$90,000, leaving an accrued balance of \$24,000 as of January 29, 2026.

Separate from the accrued balance of \$24,000, 17 additional monthly installments of \$6,000 remain under the terms of the settlement agreement. Funding is estimated to conclude by June 30, 2027. Assuming funding is completed as scheduled, the settlement administrator estimates that disbursement of the Gross Settlement Amount will be completed by mid-July 2027.

**2. MATTER OF GOMEZ, 26CV0144**

**3. SEERAT, INC. v. KINGS TRANS CARRIER INC., ET AL., 23CV1861**

**OSC Re: Dismissal**

This matter was continued from February 13, 2026, upon plaintiffs' request. On November 12, 2025, plaintiffs filed a notice of settlement of entire case. The notice of settlement indicates that the settlement is conditional and that a request for dismissal will be filed no later than January 31, 2026. To date, there is no request for dismissal in the court's file.
