

1. CONSERVATORSHIP OF TRENT J., SP20120040

Biennial Review Hearing

Before the court is the biennial review of the conservatorship of the person. The court investigator recommends continuation of the conservatorship.

TENTATIVE RULING # 1: ABSENT OBJECTION, THE CONSERVATORSHIP SHALL CONTINUE. THE COURT FINDS THAT ASSESSMENT OF THE COURT INVESTIGATOR FEE WOULD CAUSE A HARDSHIP TO THE CONSERVATORSHIP AND WILL NOT REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT OF THE FEE. THE COURT SETS THE NEXT BIENNIAL REVIEW OF CONSERVATORSHIP AT 8:30 A.M., FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2028, IN DEPARTMENT FOUR.
