

**1. ESTATE OF BRUSCO, 24PR0331****Status of Administration**

This matter was continued on the court's own motion from February 6, 2026, as the court was informed petitioner's counsel was unavailable to appear in court that day due to medical issues.

Letters of administration were issued on February 7, 2025. On June 17, 2025, petitioner submitted a Partial Inventory and Appraisal Number 1, which identifies the decedent's real property; and on October 9, 2025, petitioner submitted a "Final Inventory and Appraisal," which identifies a personal bank account and vehicle.

A final inventory and appraisal is used when it is the only inventory contemplated and, so far as is known, it lists all of the decedent's probate assets. The court deems the final inventory and appraisal filed October 9, 2025, as Partial Inventory and Appraisal Number 2. It is the court's understanding that, both Partial Inventory and Appraisals, Numbers 1 and 2, together contain a true statement of all of the estate that has come to petitioner's knowledge or possession, including particularly all money and all just claims the estate has against petitioner. At the hearing, the court will ask the petitioner to confirm this is correct.

To date, there is no petition for final distribution in the court's file.
