3. MATTER OF EDWARD W. DUNN & MIRA Y. DUNN TRUST, SP20210034**Respondent's Motion for Summary Judgment**

Respondent Pat Hansen moves for summary judgment or, alternatively, summary adjudication pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 437c against Petitioner and Successor Trustee Robert Huckaby's petition for surcharge (date June 13, 2022) and supplement to petition for surcharge (dated Nov. 1, 2022).

To date, objector still has not filed and served his written objection.
