

1. CONSERVATORSHIP OF TRENT J., SP20120040

Biennial Review Hearing

Before the court is the biennial review of the conservatorship of the person. To date, the court investigator's report is not in the court's file.

Status of Administration

Letters of Administration were issued on November 1, 2023.

The matter has been continued multiple times, as counsel for the administrator indicates he has been experiencing difficulty receiving financial documents from the IRS. To date, there is no Final Inventory and Appraisal in the court's file.

3. ESTATE OF ALMEIDA, 26PR0015**Petition to Administer Estate**

The court notes that the proof of publication shows publication on January 30, 2026, only. Probate Code section 8121 requires “[t]hree publications ..., with at least five days intervening between the first and last publication dates, not counting the publication dates.” (*Id.*, subd. (a).)

There is also no Confidential Supplement to Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative (Judicial Council Form DE-147S) in the court’s file.

The petition alleges that the decedent died intestate. On February 20, 2026, Rhonda Dobson filed an objection alleging that the decedent died testate. A copy of the alleged will is attached to Ms. Dobson’s objection. Proof of service filed February 23, 2026, shows the objection was served upon the petitioner by mail.

Lastly, the court notes that, presently, there is no request to waive bond. Based on the allegations in the petition, the court intends to impose a bond of \$200,000 (the alleged total value of the estate) before issuing Letters of Administration. (Prob. Code, § 8480, subd. (a).) However, the court notes that the will attached to Ms. Dobson’s objection waives the bond requirement.

6. CONSERVATORSHIP OF PAMELA B.L., 25PR0350**Petition to Appoint Conservator**

On January 16, 2026, the court issued letters of temporary conservatorship of the person and estate. On February 20, 2026, the court issued an order extending the temporary conservatorship to March 6, 2026.

The court investigator's report recommends establishment of the conservatorship and notes that the conservatee wishes to attend the hearing. It is presently unclear if the conservatee's estate is sufficient to warrant assessment of the investigation report fee.
