

**1. Guardianship of Riley P. PP20190155
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW**

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on November 13, 2019. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian for the initial annual review nor the continued hearing on July 1, 2026. No parties appeared at the July 1, 2026 hearing, so the court ordered Quest to conduct another court investigation. Quest filed a request with the court for a continuance to have more time to complete the investigation. However, on August 7, 2026, the guardian filed an annual status report. The report did not include a report card or other school report, as required. The court orders appearances to ensure that such a report is filed. Given the guardian filed a status report, the court vacates its order for Quest to do an investigation and directs the clerk to notify Quest that the order is vacated.

TENTATIVE RULING #1: APPEARANCES ARE REQUIRED AT 1:30 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19, 2026 IN DEPARTMENT 8. THE COURT VACATES ITS ORDER FOR QUEST TO DO AN INVESTIGATION AND DIRECTS THE CLERK TO NOTIFY QUEST THAT THE ORDER IS VACATED.

2. Guardianship of Allie V. PP20170115
TERMINATION OF GUARDIANSHIP

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on August 30, 2017. At the annual status review on July 8, 2026, one of the guardians confirmed that he separated from the other guardian (paternal grandmother, Sheri Cortez) and that the other guardian lives out of state. The court set a hearing on its own motion to terminate the guardianship as to the other guardian. Quest filed a report on July 10, 2026, which recommends maintaining the guardianship but removing the paternal grandmother as the other guardian. The court finds removal of the other guardian to be appropriate and necessary.

TENTATIVE RULING #2: THE COURT TERMINATES THE GUARDIANSHIP AS TO SHERI CORTEZ.

**3. Guardianship of Legend M. 26PR0125
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on May 4, 2026. The court appointed temporary guardians on May 20, 2026 and reissued that order at the June 24, 2026 hearing, with a new expiration date of August 19, 2026.. The court received has yet to receive the investigative report.

**4. Guardianship of Gydyon G. PP20190228
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW**

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on January 15, 2020. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) was filed by the guardians on January 9, 2026. While there were no issues noted in the report, the guardians failed to attach the child's most recent report card or to confirm where the child lives. The court ordered appearances at the May 13, 2026 hearing to address these issues, but the guardians did not appear. The court continued the matter to July 1, 2026 and directed the clerk to provide notice to the guardian. On July 14, 2026, the guardians file a new status report with a report card attached. While the court has concerns about the child's academic progress, it appears that the guardian are acting appropriately with getting the child an IEP to provide academic support.

TENTATIVE RULING #4: THE COURT FINDS THAT THE GUARDIANSHIP IS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE AND SHALL CONTINUE. THE NEXT ANNUAL STATE REVIEW SHALL BE AT 1:30 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2027 IN DEPARTMENT 8.

5. Guardianship of Aleigha V. 22PR0013
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on March 2, 2022. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian for the initial annual review nor the continued hearing on July 1, 2026. No parties appeared at the July 1, 2026 hearing, so the court ordered Quest to conduct another court investigation. Quest filed a request with the court for a continuance to have more time to complete the investigation. However, on August 10, 2026, the guardian filed an annual status report. Given the guardian filed a status report, the court vacates its order for Quest to do an investigation and directs the clerk to notify Quest that the order is vacated.

TENTATIVE RULING #5: THE COURT VACATES ITS ORDER FOR QUEST TO DO AN INVESTIGATION AND DIRECTS THE CLERK TO NOTIFY QUEST THAT THE ORDER IS VACATED. THE COURT FINDS THAT THE GUARDIANSHIP IS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE AND SHALL CONTINUE. THE NEXT ANNUAL STATE REVIEW SHALL BE AT 1:30 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2027 IN DEPARTMENT 8.

**6. Guardianship of Joseph H. 26PR0024
PETITION TO APPOINT GUARDIAN**

A Petition to Appoint a Guardian and Temporary Petition was filed on February 5, 2026. Letters of Temporary Guardianship were issued on February 10, 2026 and again April 15, 2026 and April 13, 2026. The court has yet to receive the investigator's report.

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on April 28, 2016. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council Form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian for the initial hearing but has since been filed on July 28, 2026. The report did not include a report card or other similar school report.

8. Guardianship of Lillianna P. PP20200080
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on August 5, 2020. The annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian. At the July 1, 2026 hearing, the court directed Quest to conduct another investigation. On August 12, 2026, Quest requested additional time to complete the investigation due to receiving notice of the court's order late. The court continues the matter to September 30, 2026 to allow additional time for Quest to complete the investigation. The court directs the clerk to send notice to the guardian and to Quest.

TENTATIVE RULING #8: THE COURT CONTINUES THE MATTER TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2026 AT 1:30 P.M. IN DEPARTMENT 8 TO ALLOW ADDITIONAL TIME FOR QUEST TO COMPLETE THE INVESTIGATION. THE COURT DIRECTS THE CLERK TO SEND NOTICE TO THE GUARDIAN AND TO QUEST.

9. Guardianship of Stevie B. G. PP20150079
ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW HEARING

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued April 8, 2020. The annual guardianship Status Report (Judicial Council Form GC-251) was not filed by the guardian for the initial hearing on July 8, 2026. The court continued the matter to August 19, 2026 and directed the clerk to send notice to the guardian. Upon review, the notice was returned to sender by the post office as undeliverable.

ACCOUNTING HEARING/ANNUAL STATUS REVIEW

Letters of Guardianship of the Estate were issued on May 14, 2025. Neither the annual guardianship status report (Judicial Council form GC-251) nor an accounting were filed by the guardian. However, it is not clear whether the guardian was given notice of the hearing either. The court continued the matter to July 1, 2026 and directed the clerk to provide notice to the guardian. No parties appeared and the matter was continued again. Upon review of the file, the court finds that neither the annual status report nor the accounting has been filed.

The court continued the matter to July 1, 2026 and directed the clerk to provide notice to the guardian. No parties appeared at the July 1, 2026 hearing, so the court ordered Quest to conduct another court investigation. Quest filed a request with the court for a continuance to have more time to complete the investigation. However, on July 27, 2026, the guardian filed an annual status report. The report did not include a report card or other school report, as required. The court orders appearances to ensure that such a report is filed. Given the guardian filed a status report, the court vacates its order for Quest to do an investigation and directs the clerk to notify Quest that the order is vacated.
